

UNDERSTANDING INJURY COSTS

Indirect expenses, including equipment damage, production delays, administrative tasks, and legal charges, are believed to be five to seven times higher than direct expenses. Even though oil companies might experience some direct costs from a contractor's injury, indirect expenses affect them much more.



These figures are taken from OSHA's reported findings after analyzing workers comp loss runs over a 10-year period.

PROSTAR'S PERFORMANCE

Prostar's TRIFF is 0.82 or 1 recordable every 243,902 Hours. That means Prostar's four-man crews experience:

1 INJURY EVERY 16.7 YEARS

INDUSTRY'S PERFORMANCE

The industry's TRIFF is 3.74 or 1 recordable every 53,457 Hours. That means the average conventional rig crews experience:

1 INJURY EVERY 2.9 YEARS
